A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR DOCK AND SEAWALL PERMITS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners to enact, amend, and enforce technical codes, and permit requirements; and

WHEREAS, administration of those codes demand a substantial amount of effort and resources by the County for the purpose of determining compliance with those codes; and

WHEREAS, the County has not previously established fees for some of these services; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to establish fees to provide for the review of dock and seawall permits; and

WHEREAS, the following fee schedule has been prepared by County staff to reflect the appropriate charge for dock and seawall permit and inspection fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Pasco County, Florida, in regular session duly assembled, that the fees to be charged for dock and seawall permits and inspections are as follows:

- I. Permit Fee: The initial permit fee shall be \$70.00, consisting of:
 - A. Site Examination Fee: \$40.00
 - B. Site Inspection Fee: \$30.00

The Site Examination shall consist of the verification of ownership and the field review of the application. The Site Inspection shall be conducted upon completion of construction of the dock and/or seawall.

II. Re-inspection Fees: When additional inspections are necessary due to any of the following reasons, a fee of Thirty and 00/100 Dollars (\$30.00) shall be charged for the first additional inspection; Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$60.00) for the second additional inspection; and One Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$100.00) for the third additional inspection on the same infraction.

- A. Wrong address;
- B. Construction not complete or corrections not made when inspection requested;
- C. Same work not ready for inspection when inspection requested;

- D. Permit not posted at job site; or
- E. Approved set of plans not at job site.

III. Re-permitting Fees:

A. Whenever a permit has expired, a re-permitting fee equal to the original permit fee shall be paid.

B. Where the project lacks only inspections, the re-permitting fee shall be the minimum site inspection fee.

IV. Time Extensions: Where a time extension to a permit is granted by the County Administrator, or his designee, a fee of Thirty and 00/100 Dollars (\$30.00) shall be charged.

V. Refunds on Permits:

A. No refund shall be issued on permits for the site examination or for the inspection fee where an inspection has been conducted.

B. Any applications for permit refunds shall be submitted within six (6) months of permit issuance.

C. Thirty percent (30%) of the permit fee shall be retained for administrative processing.

VI. "After the Fact" Permits: Where construction has commenced prior to the issuance of required permits, the permit fee shall be double the normal fee plus a Fifty and 00/100 Dollar (\$50.00) fine.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
