Those agencies not utilizing the Level of Service review procedures include the District School Board of Pasco County, the Pasco County Sheriff's Office, the Emergency Services Department, and the Office of Emergency Management. The assessment will consider the public health and safety of Pasco County residents and persons employed in Pasco County.

1. Estimate the total number of persons residing in the development.
2. Estimate the number of school-age children. Identify the name and location of the schools, which would serve the proposed project. Assess the impact and identify nearest school bus stop.
3. Estimate the number of residents considered part of the labor force. Labor force refers to all civilians in the institutional population 16 years and over classified as "employee" or "unemployed" as well as members of the Armed Forces stationed in the area.
4. Identify the name and location of hospitals and medical facilities serving the proposed project. Assess the impact.
5. Identify the location of fire stations, Sheriff's offices, and substations. Address the issue of response time.
6. Identify the hurricane-evacuation zone. Identify the evacuation location and/or evacuation route.
