HOW TO GET A PASCO COUNTY LICENSE TAG FOR YOUR PET

Pasco County Ordinance, Chapter 14 requires **ANNUAL** licensing for your pet. Most Pasco veterinarians and some neighboring county veterinarians sell the tags if your pet receives the rabies shot from their clinic. All others can purchase the tags at the Animal Services facility in Land O'Lakes or through the mail. If you come in person, the hours are:

12:00 Noon – 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday

12:00 Noon – 4:30 p.m. on Saturday

We are closed on Sundays and Legal Holidays.

Instructions – Send or bring with you:

1. A copy of your pet's current rabies certificate. A certificate is necessary, not just an invoice.
2. Proof of spay/neuter if applicable. (A veterinarian's invoice is proof for this.)
3. Check or money order payable to Pasco Co. Board of Co. Comm. Do not send cash through the mail.
 - \$ 25.00 for a non-neutered dog tag
 - \$ 5.00 for a neutered dog tag
 - \$ 5.00 for an optional cat tag
 - \$ 5.00 for a replacement tag
 - \$100.00 for a Rescue License for 501 (c) 3 organizations
