

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO THE PASCO COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 402.5.C.2; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A NON-DE MINIMIS ROADWAY LIST; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners adopted amended concurrency management regulations pursuant to Ordinance No. 06-36 (Concurrency Management Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, Section 402.5.C.2 of the Concurrency Management Ordinance requires the Board of County Commissioners to adopt, for the purpose of de minimis determinations under the ordinance, a list of transportation facilities that are estimated based on County estimates of existing roadway volumes and projected volumes from approved projects to exceed: 1) ninety (90) percent of the maximum volume at the adopted Level of Service of the facility (90 Percent Roadways¹), 2) 110 percent of the maximum volume at the adopted Level of Service of the facility (110 Percent Roadways²), and 3) 100 percent of the maximum volume at the adopted Level of Service for designated hurricane evacuation routes (Hurricane Evacuation Roadways²), which are collectively referred to as the Non-De Minimis Roadway List; and

WHEREAS, the County's transportation consultant, Tindale-Oliver & Associates, Inc., and the Pasco County Metropolitan Planning Organization staff have prepared a proposed non-de minimis roadway list for 2007-08; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, on November 27, 2007, held a public hearing with due public notice on the proposed 2008 Non-De Minimis Roadway List and has considered all comments received at the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pasco County, Florida, in regular session duly assembled that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the 2008 Non-De Minimis Roadway List attached hereto.
2. The 2008 Non-De Minimis Roadway List shall apply to traffic impact study applications filed after December 1, 2007.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


