NEW PORT RICHEY, Fla – A report on the future of economic development in Pasco County, from an advisory panel with the Urban Land Institute, is now posted online for the public to view. The report details the panel's findings and recommendations for the County's future economic and land development activities. The panel interviewed more than 100 community and business leaders and met with County staff during a week-long Advisory Services Panel process held in April.
